## Eligibility for Admission in UG Programmes as per CAU Imphal Regulation, 2016

## **Admission Requirements:**

- Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) with 50% marks in aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics or Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology for General/OBC/UPS Categories and 40% Marks for SC/ST/Physically Handicapped/in-service candidates.
- 2. The candidates should have passed 10+2 examination with English as one of the subject of study.
- 3. The candidates must have attained 16 Years of age on 31st August, 2020.
- 4. The selection/nomination of candidates should be made through Common Entrance Test conducted by the concerned State.
- 5. ICAR nominees shall be governed by the eligibility as prescribed by the ICAR.
- 6. The student's admission in the CAEPHT will be strictly provisional and subject to the verification of his/her original certificates and fulfilment of essential admission criterion fixed by CAU Imphal.

## Documents required at the time of admission:

- 1. Pass Certificate for 10+2 Examination,
- 2. Marks sheet of 10+2 Examination,
- 3. Certificate of High School Pass Examination in support of date of birth (Class X)
- 4. Migration certificate from the Board/ University where the candidate studied last,
- 5. College/School leaving certificate from the authority of the College/School where the candidate studied last.
- 6. Character certificate from the Principal of the College/School where the candidate studied last,
- 7. Permanent residential/domicile certificate of concerned state.
- 8. Certificate from competent authority, incase admission is sought under reserved category,
- 9. Medical certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon in support of physical fitness of the candidate,
- 10. Photocopy of Aadhar Card,
- 11. Photocopy of Bank pass book,
- 12. Any other documents (as per prospectus/notification) that may be required at the time of admission.
- 13. Affidavits on judicial stamp papers
